

Senior Portrait Day - What to expect

Please be on time and prepared for your photography session. Any makeup or hair touch ups need to be taken care of prior to checking in. We ask you please be respectful of other student's scheduled appointments.

We try to ensure other appointments will not be delayed. If you have multiple outfits (more than 2) you would like to use you will need to call and schedule a studio appointment and an additional sitting fee maybe required.

Checking in will require you to provide your first and last name, your phone number and your parent's/guardian's cell number and email address'. Please use your full legal name (no nicknames). Nicknames maybe used in addition after checking in with your legal name.

The sitting fee will also be collected at this time and you will be issued a password with your receipt. The password is used to access your portrait proofs online once they are available.

Additional Tips

If you normally wear glasses we encourage you wear them during your photo shoot. It is however your personal preference if you should decide to wear them or remove them in your portrait session.

Females: We encourage you to wear your makeup as normal and fix your hair in your favorite style. You may want to wear a tank top or bra that is easy to pull the straps down for your formal wear. Keep in mind of your tan lines when taking your Formal Portraits; it will be viewable in the drape.

Lipstick and lip gloss are also encouraged as they show up best in portraits. Fingernails and toe nails may be seen in some of your poses so consider removing chipped nail polish or re-polishing your nails prior to your session.

Poses may be limited based on your attire. Example: low cut tops, short dresses and/or shorts.
